
Families are encouraged to register their daughter's interest by completing the registration using the QR code below.

Information for families

General Information: The MCC Swim Club is a non-competitive sport opportunity

When: Tuesdays in Terms 1-4

Where: Fitness First Anderson Street, Chatswood

Time: 7am—8am

<u>Transport:</u> students will need to arrange their own transport arrangements to and from squad training.

<u>Provider:</u> Qualified Coach delivers a programme to help build cardiovascular endurance, muscle strength and stroke correction.

<u>Eligibility:</u> All ages however participants should be of a capable level looking to improve their fitness and stroke proficiency

<u>Cost per Term:</u> 1 Session a week (\$18), total \$144 per term. Payment and registration required via Compass

Additional Information

- Parents agree to pay all fees (per term) and acknowledge that this activity is an Co curricular activity that includes a user pays fee.
- Limited places are available and Active Kids Vouchers are <u>NOT</u> redeemable for MCC Swimming.
- Please note that fees as a result of absence are not redeemable.
- Term payment is required before students are permitted to commence training.
- Teacher supervisor is present at the Fitness Centre and attendance is taken at every training session. It is a requirement for all students to check in with teacher at the beginning of each session.
- Parents are not permitted on Pool deck.
- Students make their own way to and from Fitness First.
- Students must wear the correct swimwear (1 Piece Costume, Goggles and Cap—School Cap supplied). Please note that <u>Fitness First Policy stipulates No Cap</u>, <u>No Goggles No Swim policy</u>
- Once the training is finished students are to move quickly through the change rooms and leave in a timely manner. Students are reminded this area is a public space and are to behave accordingly. Students are required to arrive at school on time and in the correct uniform.

When: Term 1-4 however split into two seasons Autumn (Terms 1 and 2) and Spring (Terms 3 and 4)

- Singlets will be provided to students and must be returned at the end of the season. Charges apply if not returned.
- All players must be registered Insurance payment as above (current) with MWBA to enter the stadium.

Cost for the season:

- Junior Student Registration (11- 17 years) \$350.00
- Senior Student Registration (18 years) \$350.00
- Fees include umpire payments, coach payments, competition registration, insurance and administration, and equipment costs.
 - MCC Netball Uniform \$85 (required) is available to purchase via registration process.

<u>Transport:</u> Families to manage their own daughters transport to and from training and competition games

Additional Information:

- For eligible participants, Active Kids Voucher can be used towards payment of registration fees.
- Dates for grading will be advised based on registrations numbers. Teams are formed based on
 player ability and skill level. A reminder we play in a competitive graded competition. There is
 no guarantee that teams will be the same as last year.
- For players who purchased new uniform online a size check will be held prior to final order placed. This will be held at Day 1 grading sessions for each year group as listed above.
- All students who have registered for MCC Netball must attend all grading sessions in their age group. Students who have not registered will not be eligible to attend grading.
